Ages 40 - 70

People with no symptoms, but are at risk for heart disease, including those with the following traits:

- Have a family history of heart disease
- Past or present smoker
- History of high cholesterol, diabetes or high blood pressure
- Overweight
- Inactive lifestyle

Younger than 40

People younger than 40 may consider a Calcium CT Score if high cholesterol (familial hypercholesterolemia) runs in your family.
